- ◆ James Whitcomb becomes governor of Indiana.
- ◆ Great Wabash & Erie Canal celebration held July 4; waterway opened between Lafayette and Lake Erie.

- The daguerreotype an early type of photograph developed by Louis Daguerre — is introduced into Fort Wayne.

- ◆ Remnants of the Miami nation are taken to the Western reservation under government escort.
- ♦ Abolitionist Henry Ward Beecher establishes Second Presbyterian Church and holds a series of evangelistic meetings in the Allen County Courthouse.
