- ◆ Weigand Construction is founded.
- ◆ Spangler Candy Co., manufacturer of the Dum Dum Pops, opens in Bryan, Ohio.

1907

- ◆ Florenz Ziegfeld produces his first "Ziegfeld Follies."
- ♦ Oklahoma becomes the 46th state.
- ◆ New York City's Plaza Hotel opens.
- ◆ The steamship Lusitania makes its maiden voyage from Queenstown, Ireland, to New York.
