1920

- ◆ Women vote in their first presidential election.

- ◆ Fort Wayne's Bill Wambsganss completes an unassisted triple play in the World Series for the Cleveland Indians.
- ◆ Allen County Public Library's Woodburn branch opens.
- ♦ Anna Hinton becomes the first woman to join the Greater Fort Wayne Chamber of Commerce.

1921

- ◆ Chester Keen builds the first commercial radio transmitter in Fort Wayne. Keen and Lauer Auto start the first local station, WCWK.
- ◆ Warren G. Harding is inaugurated as the 29th president.
- ♦ America's unknown soldier of World War I is buried at Arlington National Cemetery.
- ◆ Margaret Gorman of Washington, D.C., wins the first Miss America title.
- ◆ South Side High School built.
